

Coastal Region Landfill Options for Wildfire Debris Removal Contractors

Right now, the U.S. EPA and the California Department of Toxic Substances Control are in the process of completing Phase 1 of the wildfire debris removal process. Once these hazardous waste sweeps are completed, contractors – either with the Army Corps of Engineers or those hired privately by homeowners – will begin removing ash, contaminated soil, and other debris from burned properties.

Below is a list of landfills that currently or may soon meet the regulatory requirements to accept the debris from the disaster areas. The listing of a specific facility is not an endorsement by CalRecycle or any other agency of its use and requirements are subject to change. Listed disposal sites are not obligated to take the debris and acceptance of any material is still subject to the review and approval of the disposal site operator. Landfills may stop accepting disaster material once certain capacities are reached.
